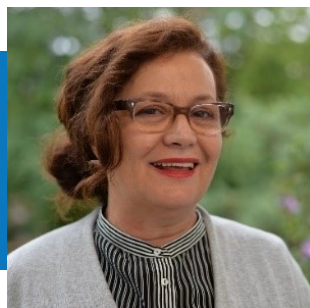

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MESSAGE BY THE VICE-PRESIDENT PROJECTS



Prioritizing education, health, economic and social wellbeing of children represents an important commitment to achieve Sustainable Development Goals for children and may ultimately contribute towards the creation of a fairer and more just world for us all. The UNWG since its inception, five decades ago, has dedicated its support to the most vulnerable and marginalised children and women living in dire circumstances by financing annual microprojects and offering multiyear scholarships to improve their chances.

In previous years through the collective efforts from the UNWG members, Permanent Missions, the United Nations and wider Geneva Community, the UNWG Bazaars raised funds to support between 50 and 60 projects yearly. Last year the funds were allocated to projects in Afghanistan, Argentina, Burkina Faso, Cameroon, Ecuador, Egypt, Mauritania, Moldova, Mongolia, Tunisia and Venezuela. Funding was provided to underprivileged and marginalized children, young mothers and their local communities and focused on providing access to health care, water, sanitation, proper nutrition and education.

UNWG also accompanies children in their education by providing scholarships for the secondary school students. Funds are primarily raised through the Children's Walk activity involving primary school children and their dedicated teachers from international schools in and around Geneva. The funds are also raised through UNWG Kiosk sales and other ad hoc donation initiatives. Currently the UNWG is supporting three multi-year scholarship programs and over 50 students are provided with funds towards school fees, school uniforms, textbooks and transportation. In addition to raising funds, the Children's Walk also aims to inspire consciousness and to promote the culture of solidarity among children living in Switzerland to the struggles of other children around the world who may not enjoy the same educational opportunities and face other challenges such as access to clean water and sanitation.

Projects Financed from the Proceeds of UNWG Bazaar 2021

AFGHANISTAN

Qamar Charity Foundation is a non-governmental organisation which responds to emergency disasters in Afghanistan and provides relief, develops innovative and sustainable solutions for individuals and communities living in poverty, tackles the root causes of poverty in any region and makes positive changes and sets up small businesses for families to support themselves in long run. The funds were used to purchase winter clothing packages for orphans of Kabul Province. Each package contained shoes, jumpers or jackets, blouses, trousers, fabrics, socks, hats and scarfs, gloves and tailor's fee.



Hope for the Babies International is a non-governmental organisation providing health education, encouraging women to deliver in a health care centre and preventing hypothermia of the new-borns. The overall objective of the project was to contribute to the decrease in maternal and infant mortalities in Afghanistan. The funds of the project were used to provide materials for knitting the sweaters for new-borns to be distributed in maternity wards around Kabul and to organise health education sessions for Afghan women.



ARGENTINA

Asociacion Cultural Bonaerense is a non-profit organisation that promotes cultural and social activities that contribute to the integral formation of people. In the framework of the Family educational project focusing on girls, adolescent girls and young mothers of La Plata the funds were used to implement educational workshops and school support for girls and to organize training courses in nutrition for their mothers. In addition, new materials and equipment were purchased for the classroom and library.



BURKINA FASO

The aim of the association **Unis Pour Agir** is to contribute to improving the living conditions of the rural population in Burkina Faso, in particular that of girls and women. The aim of the project was to provide material support to vulnerable girls who were displaced due to the insecurity in order to continue their studies in schools in neighbouring communities. The project provided solar lamps and bicycles for the most vulnerable secondary school girls aged between 13 and 15 years old in order to motivate them to continue studying and to contribute to the fight against early marriages. With the provided bicycles and lamps the girls will be able to study in the evenings and travel to school and to collect food in their villages.



CAMEROUN



TIAMA est une école maternelle et primaire à but non lucratif fondée en 2015. L'objectif de cette école est de contribuer à la transformation positive de la société. TIAMA n'a pas de but lucratif et ses bénéficiaires n'ont pas beaucoup de moyens, mais TIAMA croit à l'éducation pour tous et s'efforce d'en donner une de qualité à ses enfants. Avec effort, TIAMA cherche des bourses et applique des réductions pour les plus défavorisés et nécessiteux. Le projet financé par le CFNU a amélioré les conditions des salles de classe, le couloir et l'entrée principale qui étaient en très mauvais état et insalubres pour les petits enfants.

Association des parents d'élèves de l'école primaire d'Ilhouck est une association à but non lucratif. Les objectifs de l'association sont de créer les conditions favorables pour assurer la scolarisation des enfants en milieu rural à travers les différentes actions (mobilisation des ressources humaines, matériels et financières ; amélioration du cadre de vie scolaire) et lutter contre la déperdition des enfants et l'analphabétisme. Le projet visait à améliorer les conditions de l'école en fournissant des portes, des fenêtres, des revêtements de sol, du matériel scolaire et en construisant des toilettes pour les élèves.



EQUADOR

Fundacion Alfredo Jijon is a non-profit organisation which aims at fostering the integral health and autonomy of adolescent girls and young mothers to improve their and their children's living conditions and future opportunities. The purpose of this project was to create an organic community garden involving young mothers and adolescent girls. They were taught how to produce different foods and learnt about health and environmental protection, thus fostering personal development and providing proper nourishment to La Ribera Program participants and their families.



EGYPT

Alhassan Foundation for differently abled inclusion aims to effectively include younger generation on wheelchairs by caring for their psychological and physical health. They try to enable young wheelers physically through enhancing their mobility and overcoming the challenges using therapeutic wheelchairs. The funds were used to provide customized therapeutic wheelchairs for children who suffer from spina bifida to enable them to attend school and achieve effective inclusion in their community and to provide psychological and social rehabilitation.



Mersal Foundation is a non-profit foundation which aims at providing medical services to all who deserve it regardless of the cost and period of the treatment. In addition, they focus on spreading medical awareness among the local community. The project of "Speech, behaviour modification and skills development for children with special needs" focuses on the marginalized group in the community that cannot afford treatment. The objective of the project is that they regain their basic special sense needs, achieve self-confidence and enable them to integrate into society. This will increase their productivity in the future and give them the opportunity to participate effectively in the society. The funds were used to finance speech development sessions and behaviour modification sessions for children with cochlear implants.

MAURITANIE

Association de Cooperation pour le Development (ACD) est une association à but non lucratif. L'objectif global de ACD est de contribuer au développement à travers les objectifs spécifiques suivants: lutter contre la malnutrition des enfants et des femmes allaitantes; améliorer les conditions de vie des enfants et promouvoir leur scolarisation; concevoir et développer des modules de formation adaptés, en fonction des besoins exprimés par les populations à la base dans les domaines de environnement, eau, assainissement, santé et éducation. Le projet visait à fournir à une centaine d'enfants issus de familles extrêmement pauvres des zones rurales du pays des vêtements et des fournitures scolaires afin qu'ils puissent aller à l'école. Ces fonds ont été utilisés pour acheter des cartables, des cahiers, des crayons, des sous-vêtements, des chemises, des pantalons et des chaussures.

MOLDOVA

AO SOS AUTISM is a non-governmental organisation involved in the development of autism awareness programs, early intervention for children with autism, training of specialists, inclusion of children with autism in kindergartens and schools, workshops for children and parents, etc. Project aimed at offering support for children with autism in achieving their best potential, to provide advice and support for families of children with autism and to offer educational or leisure activities for children with autism. The funds were used to organise varied therapeutic sports activities for children with autism, to organise beneficial group meetings for mothers and children and individual psychological and legal counselling sessions for parents of children with autism.

MONGOLIA

The Development Center for Children and Youth with Disabilities (Day care and Rehabilitation centre) is a non-governmental organisation aiming to protect the rights of children with disabilities through their parents and guardians, change public perceptions and attitudes, improve access to social services, provide information to their family members and help them become active members of the society. The funds were used to improve and renovate the centre's kitchen and relaxation room to provide a variety of highly nutritional meals for children with disabilities and to provide comfortable relaxation room.



TUNISIE

ATUPE est une association à but non lucratif et l'objectif de l'association est de défendre le droit de l'enfant à une bonne éducation et offrir un enseignement de qualité; prospections des perspectives et horizons d'amélioration de la qualité des systèmes d'éducation et d'enseignement; développement des environnements scolaires, périscolaires et extrascolaires et de lutter contre l'abandon scolaire précoce. Le projet consistait à distribuer les cartables garnis aux enfants de manuels et affaires scolaires. Il s'agit d'une cinquantaine d'enfants nécessiteux issus de familles pauvres et vivant dans une région rurale fortement défavorisée.

VENEZUELA

Salud y Familia is a non-profit civil association which was created with the purpose of promoting health, physical and emotional well-being of people, especially children and women in vulnerable situations. The aim of the project was to improve oral health conditions of children and teenage mothers; to equip the dentistry unit with appropriate equipment; to increase coverage of care, especially children and mothers; to educate about the importance of oral health and promote preventive dentistry to children, their families, teachers at schools and community centres. Funds were used to purchase dentistry equipment.





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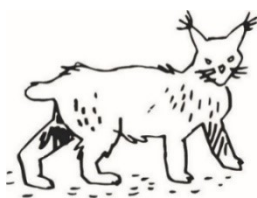

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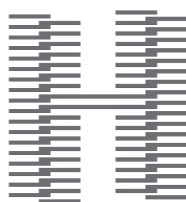


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
